A) Рубрика

Museum of Sochi Sport Honour is the newest museum in the city. The items of its collection show the history of Olympics, the Olympic movement, and Sochi participation in the organization of Olympics. The most important items are Vancouver 2010 Olympic and Paralympics flags, as well as the miniaturized models of Sochi Olympic venues.
