A) Рубрика

Ecotourism is becoming more and more popular in Russia. The cultural and environmental heritage of the country is so rich and various, that Russia can be called one of the most promising countries for the development of the ecotourism. The ecological tours give a possibility to discover the country, which could seem familiar. There is a lot to see in each region of Russia.

B) Рубрика

All of Australia's major towns have reliable, affordable public bus networks, and there are suburban train lines in all big cities. Melbourne also has trams, Sydney and Brisbane have ferries and Sydney has a light-rail line. Taxis operate Australia-wide. A number of small regional airlines operate within smaller towns. Long-distance rail travel in Australia is quite comfortable.

C) Рубрика

Lapta is a traditional Russian game, which is more than 400 years old. Two teams with a minimum of three players each are needed to play the game. A rubber ball (or tennis ball) and bats are used. A traditional *lapta* bat has a spade-like shape. But today round ones are also used, similar to baseball bats. The field is around 30-40 yards wide and 40–55 yards long.

D) Рубрика

Set up by Edward Stanford in 1853, the Stanfords flagship bookstore has been situated in a grand old building in London since 1901. The customers can find a great variety of travel guides, maps, gifts and more spread over three floors. Stanfords claims to be the world's largest specialist travel bookstore. There's also a cafe located in the store that serves cakes, pastries and hot drinks.

Alexander Sergeevich Pushkin was a Russian Romantic author who is considered to be the greatest Russian poet. In his poems and plays he created a style of storytelling – mixing drama, romance, and satire – associated with Russian style ever since and greatly influencing later Russian writers. Pushkin published his first poem at the age of fifteen.

FEDOR

FEDOR is a Russian super robot. It can perform many different functions, such as driving a car or physical exercises. *FEDOR* can also do household tasks like open doors, insert a key into a lock and lift weights. The robot can work independently, respond to voice, and it can be from different places. Russian scientists and engineers say that soon *FEDOR* will be good at decisions.

FEDOR will also fly into space by 2022. Russian engineers do not say what the robot will do in space. Perhaps, it will work outside the aircraft to take on tasks too for astronauts.
