A) Рубрика

In 1749 the Dutch House in Kuskovo was erected in memory of Peter the Great, whom Field Marshal Boris Sheremetev served as companion-in-arms. This house is modeled on typical late seventeenth-century Dutch town house. It is a two-storey brick building. The house was plastered and painted in imitation of brickwork.

This organization was formed after the end of the First World War (1914–1918). Its main purpose was to stop any future wars from happening.
